The One God

- Ex 20:1-3 And God spoke all these words, saying: I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. You shall have no other gods before Me (Deut 5:6-7)
- Deut 4:39 the LORD Himself is God in heaven above and on the earth beneath; there is no other
- Deut 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one
- Deut 32:39 Now see that I, even I, am He, And there is no God besides Me
- Neh 9:6 You alone are the LORD...The host of heaven worships You
- **1 Kings 8:23** *LORD God of Israel, there is no God in heaven above or on the earth below like You,* who keep Your covenant and mercy with Your servants who walk before You with all their heart
- Isa 37:16,20 O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, the One who dwells between the cherubim, You are God, You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth...O LORD our God...You are the LORD, You alone
- Isa 42:8 I am the LORD, that is My name; And My glory I will not give to another
- Isa 43:10-11 Before Me there was no God formed, Nor shall there be after Me. I, even I, am the LORD, And besides Me there is no savior
- Isa 45:14,18,21-22 They will make supplication to you, saying, Surely God is in you, And there is no other; There is no other God...For thus says the LORD...Who is God...I am the LORD, and there is no other...there is no other God besides Me, A just God and a Savior; There is none besides Me...For I am God, and there is no other
- **Isa 46:9-10** For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me. Declaring the end from the beginning, And from ancient times things that are not yet
- Hos 13:4 I am the LORD your God Ever since the land of Egypt, And you shall know no God but Me; For there is no savior besides Me
- **Joel 2:27** Then you shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, And that **I am the LORD your God And there is no other**, My people shall never be put to shame
- **Zech 14:9** And **the LORD shall be King over all the earth**. In that day it shall be—**The LORD is one, and His name one**
- Mark 10:18 Jesus said to him, Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God

- Mark 12:28-34 Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, Which is the first commandment of all? Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is: Hear, O Israel, The LORD our God, the LORD is one. And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these. So the scribe said to Him, Well said, Teacher. You have spoken the truth, for there is one God, and there is no other but He. And to love Him with all the heart, with all the understanding, with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love one's neighbor as oneself, is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. So when Jesus saw that he answered wisely, He said to him, You are not far from the kingdom of God
- **John 14:28** You have heard Me say to you, I am going away and coming back to you. If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, I am going to the Father, for **My Father is greater than I**
- **John 17:3** this is eternal life, that they may know **You, the only true God**, and Jesus Christ
- **Rom 3:30** there is one God who will justify the circumcised by faith and the uncircumcised
- **1 Cor 8:4-6** there is no other God but one. For even if there are so-called gods...yet for us there is only one God, the Father, of whom are all things...and one Lord Jesus Christ
- Gal 3:20 Now a mediator does not mediate for one only, but God is one
- **Eph 4:4-6** There is...one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all
- **1 Tim 1:17** to the King eternal...to **God who alone is wise**, be honor and glory forever and ever
- 1 Tim 2:5 there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus
- 1 Tim 6:13-16 I urge you in the sight of God, who gives life to all things, and before Christ Jesus who witnessed the good confession before Pontius Pilate, that you keep this commandment without spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing, which He will manifest in His own time, He who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone has immortality, dwelling in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see, to whom be honor and everlasting power (Deut 10:17; Ps 136:1-3)
- James 2:19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble

 1 John 5:19-20 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked
 one. And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we
 may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the
 true God and eternal life
- **Jude 1:4** For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into licentiousness and deny **the only Lord God** and our Lord Jesus Christ
- Rev 15:4 For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You

God (The Word)

Gen 32:22-30 Now he arose that night and took his two wives, his two maidservants, and his eleven sons, and crossed the ford of Jabbok. He took them, sent them over the brook, and sent over what he had. Then Jacob was left alone; and a Man wrestled with him until the breaking of the day. Now when He saw that He did not prevail against him, He touched the socket of his hip; and the socket of Jacob's hip was out of joint as He wrestled with him. And He said, Let Me go, for the day breaks. But he said, I will not let You go unless You bless me! So He said to him, What is your name? And he said, Jacob. And He said, Your name shall no longer be called Jacob, but

- Israel; for you have struggled with God and with men and have prevailed. Then Jacob asked Him, saying, Tell me Your name, I pray. And He said, Why is it that you ask about My name? And He blessed him there. And Jacob named the name of the place Peniel: For I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved
- Deut 18:15-19 The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear, according to all you desired of the LORD your God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, nor let me see this great fire anymore, lest I die. And the LORD said to me: What they have spoken is good. I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. And it shall be that whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him
- Joshua 5:13-15 a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said...Are You for us or for our adversaries? So He said, No, but as Commander of the army of the LORD I have now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshipped, and said to Him, What does my Lord say to His servant? Then the Commander of the LORD'S army said to Joshua, Take the sandal off your foot, for the place where you stand is holy
- Ps 2:1-12 Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against the LORD and against His Anointed (Acts 4:25-26), saying, Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us. He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The LORD shall hold them in derision. Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure: Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion. I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, You are My Son, Today I have begotten You (Heb 1:5). Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession. You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth. Serve the LORD with fear, And rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him
- Ps 45:2-3,6-7 You are fairer than the sons of men; Grace is poured upon Your lips; Therefore God has blessed You forever. Gird Your sword upon Your thigh, O Mighty One, With Your glory and Your majesty... Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You love righteousness and hate wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions (Heb 1:8-9)
- Ps 110:1-5 The LORD said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool (Heb 1:13). The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies! Your people shall be volunteers In the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of your youth. The LORD has sworn And will not relent, You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek. The Lord is at Your right hand; He shall execute kings in the day of His wrath. He shall judge among the nations, He shall fill the places with dead bodies, He shall execute the heads of many countries (Heb 5:6,10)
- **Isa 4:2** In that day **the Branch of the LORD** shall be beautiful and glorious; And the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and appealing For those of Israel who have escaped

- Isa 9:6-7 For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this
- Isa 11:1-5 There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD. His delight is in the fear of the LORD, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears; But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked. Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins, And faithfulness
- **Isa 19:19-20** In that day there will be an altar to the LORD in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the LORD at its border. And it will be for a sign and for a witness to the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt; for they will cry to the LORD because of oppressors, and **He will send them a Savior and a Mighty One**, and He will deliver them
- Isa 42:1-4 Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles. He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, Nor cause His voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax he will not quench; He will bring forth justice for truth. He will not fail nor be discouraged, Till He has established justice in the earth; And the coastlands shall wait for His law (Matt 12:18-21)
- **Isa 51:9-10** Awake, awake, put on strength, **O arm of the LORD!** Awake as in the ancient days, In the generations of old. Are you not **the arm that cut Rahab apart, And wounded the serpent?** Are you not **the One who dried up the sea, The waters of the great deep; That made the depths of the sea a road For the redeemed to cross over**
- **Isa 52:10,13** The LORD has made bare **His holy arm** In the eyes of all the nations; And all the ends of the earth shall see The salvation of our God...Behold, **My Servant** shall deal prudently, He shall be exalted and extolled and be very high. Just as many were astonished at you, So His visage was marred more than any man
- Isa 53:1-2,10-12 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

 For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him...Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief...By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many...Because He poured out His soul unto death
- Jer 23:5-6 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; A King shall reign and prosper, And execute justice and righteousness in the earth. In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS
- **Dan 7:13** *One like the Son of Man...He came to the Ancient of Days*
- **Hos 12:3-4** He took his brother by the heel in the womb, And in his strength **he struggled with God. Yes, he struggled with the Angel** and prevailed; He wept, and sought favor from Him
- Micah 5:2-5 But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me, The One to be ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth have been from of old, From everlasting. Therefore He shall give them up, Until the time that she who is in labor has given birth; Then the remnant of His brethren Shall return to the children of Israel. And

- He shall stand and feed His flock In the strength of the LORD, In the majesty of the name of the LORD His God. And they shall abide, For now He shall be great To the ends of the earth. And **this One** shall be peace
- **Zech 2:8-12** For thus says the LORD of hosts: He sent **Me** after glory, to the nations which plunder you; for he who touches you touches the apple of His eye. For surely I will shake My hand against them, and they shall become spoil for their servants. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent **Me**. Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For behold, I am coming and I will dwell in your midst, says the LORD. Many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that day, and they shall become My people. And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent **Me** to you
- **Zech 3:8** Hear, O Joshua, the high priest, You and your companions who sit before you, For they are a wondrous sign; For behold, I am bringing forth **My Servant the Branch**...And I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day. In that day, says the LORD of hosts, Everyone will invite his neighbor Under his vine and under his fig tree
- **Zech 4:9** Then you will know That the LORD of hosts has sent **Me** to you
- **Zech 6:12-15** Thus says the LORD of hosts, saying: Behold, **the Man whose name is the Branch**! From His place He shall branch out, And He shall build the temple of the LORD; Yes, He shall build the temple of the LORD. He shall bear the glory, And He shall sit and rule on His throne; So He shall be a priest on His throne, And the counsel of peace shall be between them both
- **Zech 13:7** Awake, O sword, against **My Shepherd**, Against **the Man who is My Companion**, Says the LORD of hosts. Strike **the Shepherd**, And the sheep will be scattered (Matt 26:31)
- Mal 3:1 Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. And the LORD, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming, Says the LORD of hosts
- John 1:1-2 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with [the] God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with [the] God
- **1 John 1:1-2** That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, concerning **the Word of life** the life was manifested, and we have seen, and bear witness, and declare to you that eternal life which was with the Father and was manifested to us
- Rev 19:13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood...His name is called The Word of God

God (Jesus Christ)

- Matt 1:21-23 And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins. Now all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel, which is translated, God with us (Isa 7:14)
- John 8:58 Jesus said to them, most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM
- John 20:28 And Thomas answered and said to Him, My Lord and my God
- 1 Cor 10:4 they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ
- **1 Tim 3:16** *God* [GK Who] was manifested in the flesh, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, Received up to glory
- Heb 7:1-3 For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God...without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, remains a priest continually

God and Jesus Christ

- Titus 2:13 looking for the...hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ [KJV the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ]
- **2 Pet 1:1** To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of **our God and Savior Jesus Christ** [KJV **of God and our Savior Jesus Christ**]

The Ark Of God

Ex 34:28 He wrote on the tablets the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments

- **Deut 31:24-26** So it was, when Moses had completed writing the words of this law in a book...that Moses commanded the Levites, who bore **the ark of the covenant of the LORD**, saying: Take this Book of the Law, and put it beside **the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God**, that it may be there as a witness against you
- **Judg 20:27** So the children of Israel inquired of the LORD...**the ark of the covenant of God** was there
- **1 Sam 4:4-5** the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from there **the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, who dwells between the cherubim**. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and

 Phinehas, were there with **the ark of the covenant of God**. And when **the ark of the covenant of the LORD** came into the camp, all Israel shouted so loudly that the earth shook
- 2 Sam 6:2 And David arose and went with all the people who were with him from Baale Judah to bring up from there the ark of God, whose name is called by the Name, the LORD of Hosts, who dwells between the cherubim
- 1 Kings 8:6,9 the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD to its place, into the inner sanctuary of the temple, to the Most Holy Place, under the wings of the cherubim...There was nothing in the ark except the two tablets of stone which Moses put there at Horeb, when the LORD made a covenant with the children of Israel, when they came out of the land of Egypt
- Ps 80:1 Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, You who lead Joseph like a flock; You who dwell between the cherubim, shine forth
- **Rev 11:19** Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and **the ark of His covenant** was seen in His temple

The House Of God

- Gen 28:16-22 Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, Surely the LORD is in this place, and I did not know it. And he was afraid and said, How awesome is this place! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven! Then Jacob rose early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put at his head, set it up as a pillar, and poured oil on top of it. And he called the name of that place Bethel [House of God]; but the name of that city had been Luz previously. Then Jacob made a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and clothing to put on, so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the LORD shall be my God. And this stone which I have set as a pillar shall be God's house, and all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You
- **Ex 40:34** the cloud covered **the tabernacle of meeting**, and the glory of the LORD filled **the tabernacle**. And Moses was not able to enter **the tabernacle of meeting**, because the cloud rested above it, and the glory of the LORD filled **the tabernacle**

- **Lev 26:2,11-12** You shall keep My Sabbaths and reverence **My sanctuary**: I am the LORD...I will set **My tabernacle** among you, and My soul shall not abhor you. I will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people
- **Num 7:89** Now when Moses went into **the tabernacle of meeting** to speak with Him, he heard the voice of One speaking to him from above the mercy seat that was on the ark of the Testimony, from between the two cherubim; thus He spoke to him
- **Jos 22:19** if the land of your possession is unclean, then cross over to the land of the possession of the LORD, where **the LORD'S tabernacle** stands...do not rebel against the LORD...by building yourselves an altar besides the altar of the LORD our God
- **Judg 20:18** the children of Israel arose and went up to **the house of God** to ask counsel of God...And the LORD said, Judah shall go up first
- Judg 21:2 Then the people came to the house of God, and remained there before God
- 1 Kings 8:4-6,10-13 they brought up the ark of the LORD, the tabernacle of meeting, and all the holy furnishings that were in the tabernacle...Then the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD to its place, into the inner sanctuary of the temple, to the Most Holy Place, under the wings of the cherubim...And it came to pass, when the priests came out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD, so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the LORD filled the house of the LORD. Then Solomon spoke: The LORD said He would dwell in the dark cloud, I have surely built for You an exalted house, And a place for You to dwell in forever
- **1 Chron 28:6** It is your son Solomon who shall build **My house** and **My courts**; for I have chosen him to be My son, and I will be his Father
- **2 Chron 2:4-6** I am building **a temple for the name of the LORD my God**, to dedicate it to Him...But who is able to build Him **a temple**, since heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him? Who am I then, that I should build Him **a temple**, except to burn sacrifice before Him
- **2 Chron 5:13-14** the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud...for the glory of the LORD filled the house of God
- 2 Chron 24:4-7,17-18 Now it happened after this that Joash set his heart on repairing the house of the LORD. Then he gathered the priests and the Levites, and said to them, Go out to the cities of Judah, and gather from all Israel money to repair the house of your God from year to year, and see that you do it quickly. However the Levites did not do it quickly. So the king called Jehoiada the chief priest, and said to him, Why have you not required the Levites to bring in from Judah and from Jerusalem the collection, according to the commandment of Moses the servant of the LORD and of the congregation of Israel, for the tabernacle of witness? For the sons of Athaliah, that wicked woman, had broken into the house of God, and had also presented all the dedicated things of the house of the LORD to the Baals...Now after the death of Jehoiada the leaders of Judah came and bowed down to the king. And the king listened to them. Therefore they left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served wooden images and idols; and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem because of their trespass
- **Ezra 7:23** Whatever is commanded by the God of heaven, let it be diligently be done for **the house of the God of heaven**
- **Ps 23:1,6** The LORD is my Shepherd; I shall not want...Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever
- **Isa 37:14-17** Hezekiah went up to **the house of the LORD**...Then Hezekiah prayed to the LORD, saying: O LORD of hosts, God of Israel...You are God...hear all the words of Sennacherib, who has sent to reproach the living God

- Jer 7:2-4,9-12 Stand in the gate of the LORD'S house, and proclaim there this word, and say, Hear the word of the LORD, all you of Judah who enter in at these gates to worship the LORD! Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel...Do not trust in these lying words, saying, The temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD are these...Will you...burn incense to Baal, and walk after other gods...and then come and stand before Me, in this house which is called by My name...Has this house, which is called by My name, become a den of thieves in your eyes...go now to My place which was in Shiloh, where I set My name at the first, and see what I did to it because of the wickedness of My people Israel
- **Ezek 43:5-7** the glory of the LORD filled **the temple**. Then I heard Him speaking to me from **the temple**...And He said to me, Son of man, this is the place of My throne and the place of the soles
 of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever
- Matt 21:12-13 Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple...And He said to them, It is written, My house shall be called a house of prayer, but you have made it a den of thieves
- Matt 27:50-51 Jesus, when He had cried out again with a loud voice, yielded up His spirit. And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom
- **John 2:16** Do not make **My Father's house** a house of merchandise
- John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions
- Rev 15:5 the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened
- **Rev 21:22** I saw no temple in it, for **the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple**

The God Of Abraham, Isaac, And Jacob The God Of Our Fathers

- Gen 28:10-15 Now Jacob went out from Beersheba and went toward Haran. So he came to a certain place and stayed there all night, because the sun had set. And he took one of the stones of that place and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place to sleep. Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set on the earth, and its top reaching to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it. And behold, the LORD stood above it and said: I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give it to you and your descendants. Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed. Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you
- **Gen 50:24** And Joseph said to his brethren, I am dying; but **God** will surely visit you, and bring you out of this land of which **He swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob**
- Ex 2:24 God heard their groaning, and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob
- Ex 3:2-7,10,13-18 And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush burned with fire, but the bush was not consumed. Then Moses said, I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn. So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, Moses, Moses! And he said, Here I am. Then He said, Do not draw near this place. Take the sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground. Moreover He said, I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And

Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look upon God. And the LORD said...Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt...Then Moses said to God, Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they say to me, What is His Name? what shall I say to them? And God said to Moses, I AM WHO I AM. And He said, Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, I AM has sent me to you. Moreover God said to Moses, Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations. Go and gather the elders of Israel together, and say to them, The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, of Isaac, and of Jacob, appeared to me, saying, I have surely visited you and seen what is done to you in Egypt...Then they will heed your voice; and you shall come, you and the elders of Israel, to the king of Egypt; and you shall say to him, The LORD God of the Hebrews has met with us; and now, please, let us go three days' journey into the wilderness, that we may sacrifice to the LORD our God

- Ex 4:4-5 Then the LORD said to Moses, Reach out your hand and take it by the tail (and he reached out his hand and caught it, and it became a rod in his hand), that they may believe that the LORD God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has appeared to you
- **Ex 6:2-8** And God spoke to Moses and said to him: I am the LORD. **I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac,** and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by My name, LORD, I was not known to them. I have also established My covenant with them, to give them the land of Canaan...and I have remembered My covenant. Therefore say to the children of Israel: I am the LORD...I will take you as My people, and I will be your God...And I will bring you into the land which **I swore to give to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob**, and I will give it to you as a heritage: I am the LORD
- **Lev 26:42,44-46** I will remember **My covenant with Jacob, and My covenant with Isaac and My covenant with Abraham** I will remember...for I am the LORD their God. But for their sake I will remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their God; I am the LORD. These are the statutes and judgments and laws which the LORD made between Himself and the children of Israel on Mount Sinai by the hand of Moses
- 1 Chron 29:18-20 O LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, our fathers...give my son Solomon a loyal heart to keep Your commandments and Your testimonies and Your statutes, to do all these things, and to build the temple for which I have made provision. Then David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. So all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed their heads and prostrated themselves before the LORD and the king
- **2 Chron 13:12** Now look, God Himself is with us as our head, and His priests with sounding trumpets to sound the alarm against you. **O children of Israel, do not fight against the LORD God of your fathers**, for you shall not prosper
- 2 Chron 20:6-9 O LORD God of our fathers, are You not God in heaven, and do You not rule over all the kingdoms of the nations...Are You not our God, who drove out the inhabitants of this land before Your people Israel, and gave it to the descendants of Abraham Your friend forever? And they dwelt in it, and have built You a sanctuary in it for Your name...for Your name is in this temple
- Matt 22:29-32 Jesus answered and said to them...concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying, I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living

- Mark 12:24-27 Jesus answered and said to them...concerning the dead, that they rise, have you not read in the book of Moses, in the burning bush passage, how God spoke to him, saying, I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living
- **Luke 20:34,37-38** And Jesus answered...Now even Moses showed in the burning bush passage that the dead are raised, when he called **the Lord the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**. For He is not the God of the dead but of the living, for all live to Him
- Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His Servant Jesus
- Acts 5:30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus whom you murdered by hanging on a tree
- Acts 7:30-32 an Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire in a bush, in the wilderness of Mount Sinai. When Moses saw it, he marveled at the sight; and as he drew near to observe, the voice of the Lord came to him, saying, I am the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob...Then the LORD said to him, Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground
- **Acts 22:14** The God of our fathers has chosen you that you should know His will, and see the Just One, and hear the voice of His mouth
- Acts 24:14 according to the Way which they call a sect, so I worship the God of my fathers

The God Of Jacob; The God Of Israel; The LORD God Of Israel

- Ex 5:1-3 Moses and Aaron went in and told Pharaoh, This says the LORD God of Israel: Let My people go, that they may hold a feast to Me in the wilderness. And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I do not know the LORD, nor will I let Israel go. So they said, The God of the Hebrews has met with us. Please, let us go three days journey into the desert and sacrifice to the LORD our God
- 1 Kings 8:17-21 Now it was in the heart of my father David to build a house for the name of the LORD God of Israel...and I have filled the position of my father David, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised; and I have built a house for the name of the LORD God of Israel. And there I have made a place for the ark, in which is the covenant of the LORD which He made with our fathers, when He brought them out of the land of Egypt
- 1 Chron 17:24 The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, is Israel's God
- **Ps 46:4-7,11** There is a river whose streams shall make glad the city of God, The holy place of the tabernacle of the Most High. The LORD of hosts is with us; **The God of Jacob** is our refuge. The LORD of hosts is with us; **The God of Jacob** is our refuge
- Isa 37:16 O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, the One who dwells between the cherubim, You are God, You alone
- **Isa 48:1-2** Hear this, **O** house of Jacob, Who are called by the name of Israel, And have come forth from the wellsprings of Judah; Who swear by the name of the LORD, And make mention of **the God of Israel**, But not in truth or in righteousness; For they call themselves after the holy city, And lean on **the God of Israel**; **The LORD of hosts is His name**
- **Jer 7:21-23** Thus says **the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel**...Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people
- Jer 25:15,27 thus says the LORD God of Israel... Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel
- **Mal 2:16** the LORD God of Israel says That He hates divorce, For it covers one's garment with violence, Says the LORD of hosts

The Holy One Of Israel; The Redeemer Of Israel, The Rock Of Israel

- Deut 32:3-4,6,15,18,30-31 I proclaim the name of the LORD: Ascribe greatness to our God. He is the Rock, His work is perfect; For all His ways are justice, A God of truth and without injustice; Righteous and upright is He...Do you thus deal with the LORD, O foolish and unwise people? Is He not your Father, who bought you? Has He not made you and established you...But Jeshurun grew fat and kicked; You grew fat, you grew thick, You are covered with fat; Then he forsook God who made him, And scornfully esteemed the Rock of his salvation...Of the Rock who begot you, you are unmindful, And have forgotten the God who fathered you...How could one chase a thousand, And two put ten thousand to flight, Unless their Rock had sold them, And the LORD had surrendered them? For their rock is not like our Rock
- 1 Sam 2:2 There is none holy like the LORD...there is none besides You, Nor is there any rock like our God
- **2 Sam 22:2-3** The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; The God of my strength, In Him I will trust, My shield and the horn of my salvation, My stronghold and my refuge; My Savior, You save me from violence
- 2 Sam 22:47 The LORD lives! Blessed be my Rock! Let God be exalted, The Rock of my salvation
- **2 Sam 23:1-4** Now these are the last words of David. Thus says David the son of Jesse; Thus says the man raised up on high, The anointed of the God of Jacob, And the sweet psalmist of Israel: The Spirit of the LORD spoke by me, And His word was on my tongue. **The God of Israel said, The Rock of Israel spoke to me**: He who rules over men must be just, Ruling in the fear of God
- **Ps 18:1-2,31,46** I will love You, O LORD, my strength. **The LORD is my rock** and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold...For who is God except the LORD? And **who is a rock except our God**...The LORD lives! **Blessed be my Rock**! Let the God of my salvation be exalted
- Ps 28:1 To You I will cry, O LORD my Rock
- **Ps 78:34-35** When He slew them, then they sought Him; And they returned and sought diligently for God. Then they remembered that **God was their rock, And the Most High God their Redeemer**
- **Ps 89:20,25-27** I have found My servant David; With My holy oil I have anointed him...I will set his hand over the sea, And...over the rivers. He shall cry to Me, **You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation**. Also I will make him My firstborn, The highest of the kings of the earth
- **Ps 92:13-15** Those who are planted in the house of the LORD Shall flourish in the courts of our God.

 They shall still bear fruit in old age; They shall be fresh and flourishing, To declare that **the LORD is upright; He is my rock**, and there is no unrighteousness in Him
- **Ps 95:1-7** O come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to **the rock of our salvation**. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms. For the LORD is the great God, and the great King above all gods. In His hand are the deep places of the earth; The heights of the hills are his also. The sea is His, for He made it; And His hands formed the dry land. Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker. For He is our God, And we are the people of His pasture, And the sheep of His hand
- **Isa 12:6** Cry out and shout, O inhabitant of Zion, For great is **the Holy One of Israel** in your midst **Isa 30:15,29** For thus says **the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel**: In returning and rest you shall be saved; In quietness and confidence shall be your strength...To come into **the mountain of the LORD**, To **the Mighty One of Israel**
- **Isa 37:21-23** Thus says the LORD God of Israel...Against whom have you raised your voice, And lifted up your eyes on High? Against **the Holy One of Israel**

- Isa 41:14-17,20 Fear not, you worm Jacob, You men of Israel! I will help you, says the LORD And your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel. Behold, I will make you into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; You shall thresh the mountains and beat them small, And make the hills like chaff. You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away, And the whirlwind shall scatter them; You shall rejoice in the LORD, And glory in the Holy One of Israel. When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, And their tongues fail for thirst, I, the LORD, will hear them; I, the God of Israel, will not forsake them...That they may see and know, And consider and understand together, That the hand of the LORD has done this, And the Holy One of Israel has created it
- Isa 43:1-3,14-15,25 But now, thus says the LORD, who created you, O Jacob, And He who formed you, O Israel: Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; You are mine, When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you. For I am the LORD your God, The Holy One of Israel, your Savior; I gave Egypt for your ransom, Ethiopia and Serbia in your place...Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, The Holy One of Israel: For your sake I will send to Babylon, And bring them all down as fugitives—The Chaldeans, who rejoice in their ships. I am the LORD, your Holy One, The Creator of Israel, your King...I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own name's sake...will not remember your sins
- **Isa 45:11-13** Thus says **the LORD, The Holy One of Israel, and his Maker**...He shall build My city And let My exiles go free, Not for price nor reward, Says the LORD of hosts
- Isa 47:4 As for our Redeemer, the LORD of hosts is His name, The Holy One of Israel
- Isa 48:17 Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer, The Holy One of Israel: I am the LORD your God
- Isa 49:7,26 Thus says the LORD, The Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One, To Him whom man despises, To Him whom the nation abhors, To the Servant of rulers; Kings shall see and arise, Princes also shall worship, Because of the LORD who is faithful, The Holy One of Israel; And He has chosen You...All flesh shall know That I, the LORD, am your Savior, And your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob
- **Isa 54:5** For your Maker is your husband [from baal], The LORD of hosts is His name; And **your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel**; He is called the God of the whole earth
- **Isa 55:5** Because of the LORD your God, And the Holy One of Israel; For He has glorified you
- Isa 63:15-16 Look down from heaven, And see from Your habitation, holy and glorious. Where are Your zeal and Your strength, The yearning of Your heart and Your mercies toward me? Are they restrained? Doubtless You are our Father, Though Abraham was ignorant of us, And Israel does not acknowledge us, You, O LORD, are our Father; Our Redeemer from Everlasting is Your name
- **Ezek 39:7-8** I will make My holy name known in the midst of My people Israel, and I will not let them profane My holy name anymore. Then the nations shall know that **I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel**. Surely it is coming, and it shall be done, says the Lord GOD

The Living God

- **Deut 5:26** who is there of all flesh who has heard **the voice of the living God** speaking in the midst of the fire, as we have, and lived
- **Jos 3:10-11** And Joshua said, By this you shall know that **the living God** is among you...Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth is crossing over before you into the Jordan

- 1 Sam 17:26,36,45 For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God... Your servant has killed both lion and bear; and this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, seeing he has defied the armies of the living God... Then David said to the Philistine, You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel
- **Ps 84:1-3** How lovely are Your tabernacle, O LORD of hosts! My soul longs, yes, even faints For the courts of the LORD; My heart and my flesh cry out for **the living God**. Even the sparrow has found a home, And the swallow a nest for herself, Where she may lay her young—Even Your altars, O LORD of hosts, My King and my God
- **Isa 37:17** Incline Your ear, O LORD...and hear all the words of Sennacherib, who has sent to reproach **the living God**
- Jer 10:10 the LORD is the true God; He is the living God and the everlasting King
- **Jer 23:36** you have perverted **the words of the living God**, the LORD of hosts, our God
- **Dan 6:26** I make a decree that in every dominion of my kingdom men must tremble and fear before the God of Daniel. For **He is the living God**, And steadfast forever; His kingdom is one which shall not be destroyed, And His dominion shall endure forever
- **Hos 1:10** Yet the number of the children of Israel Shall be as the sand of the sea, Which cannot be measured or numbered. And it shall come to pass In the place where it was said to them, You are not My people, There it shall be said to them, **You are the sons of the living God**
- Matt 16:16 Simon Peter answered and said, You are the Christ, the Son of the living God
- Matt 26:63 Jesus kept silent. And the high priest answered and said to Him, I adjure You by the living God that You tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God
- **Rom 9:26** There they will be called **sons of the living God** (Hosea 1:10)
- **2 Cor 3:2-3** You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read by all men; you are manifestly an epistle of Christ, ministered to us, written not with ink but by **the Spirit of the living God**, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart
- **2 Cor 6:16-18** For you are **the temple of the living God**. As God has said...I will be their God, and they shall be My people...I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty
- 1 Tim 3:15 the house of God, which is the church of the living God
- **1 Tim 4:10** we trust in **the living God**, who is the Savior of all men
- **1 Tim 6:17** Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in **the living God**
- Heb 9:14 the blood of Christ...purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God
- **Heb 12:22** you have come to Mount Zion and to **the city of the living God**, the heavenly Jerusalem

The God Of Heaven And Earth

- **Gen 24:3,7** swear by **the LORD, the God of heaven and the God of the earth**...**The LORD God of heaven**...He will send His angel before you
- Deut 4:39 the LORD Himself is God in heaven above and in the earth beneath
- Deut 10:14 heaven and the highest heavens belong to the LORD your God, also the earth with all that is in it
- Jos 2:11 the LORD your God, He is God in heaven above and on earth beneath
- Jos 3:11,13 the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth...the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth

- Ezra 5:11 We are the servants of the God of heaven and earth
- **Ezra 7:21-23** whatever Ezra the priest, **the scribe of the Law of the God of heaven**, may require of you...Whatever is commanded by **the God of heaven**, let it diligently be done for the house of **the God of heaven**
- **Ps 136:26** Oh, give thanks to **the God of heaven**! For His mercy endures forever
- **Isa 54:5** For your Maker is your husband [from baal], The LORD of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; **He is called the God of the whole earth**
- **Dan 2:44** And in the days of these kings **the God of heaven** will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed

The Almighty God

- **Gen 17:1** When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared Abram and said to him, **I am Almighty God**; walk before Me and be blameless
- **Gen 35:11-12** God said to him: **I am God Almighty**. Be fruitful and multiply...The land which I gave to Abraham and Isaac I give to you
- **Ex 6:2-3** God spoke to Moses and said to him: I am the LORD. I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as **God Almighty**, but by My name, LORD, I was not known to them
- **Job 40:1-2** Moreover the LORD answered Job, and said: Shall the one who contends with **the Almighty** correct Him? He who rebukes God, let him answer it
- **Isa 13:6,13** for the day of the LORD is at hand! It will come as destruction from **the Almighty**...In the wrath of the LORD of hosts And in the day of His fierce anger
- **Joel 1:15** For the day of the LORD is at hand; It shall come as destruction from **the Almighty**
- Rev 4:8 they do not rest day or night, saying: Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come
- **Rev 11:17** We give you thanks, **O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come**, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned
- Rev 15:3 Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty... O King of the saints
- **Rev 16:7,14** Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments...the battle of that great day of God Almighty
- Rev 19:15 He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God
- **Rev 21:22** I saw no temple in it, for **the Lord God Almighty** and the Lamb are its temple

The Most High God

- **Gen 14:18-22** Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of **God Most High**. And he blessed him and said: Blessed be **Abram of God Most High**, Possessor of
 heaven and earth; And blessed be **God Most High**, Who has delivered your enemies into your
 hand. Now the king of Sodom said to Abram, Give me the persons, and take the goods for
 yourself. But Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lifted my hand to the LORD, **God Most High**, the Possessor of heaven and earth
- **Num 24:16** The utterance of him who hears the words of God, And knows the knowledge of **the Most High**, Who sees the vision of the Almighty
- **Deut 32:7-9** Remember the days of old...When **the Most High** divided their inheritance to the nations...According to the number of the children of Israel. For the LORD'S portion is His people; Jacob is the place of His inheritance

- **Isa 14:13-14** For you have said in your heart; I will ascend into heaven...I will also sit on the mount of the congregation...I will be like **the Most High**
- Dan 3:26 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, servants of the Most High God
- **Dan 4:2-3,17,24,34** I thought it good to declare the signs and wonders that **the Most High God** has worked for me...His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom...**the Most High** rules in the kingdom of men...this is **the decree of the Most High**...**the Most High** rules in the kingdom of men...I blessed **the Most High** and praised and honored Him who lives forever
- **Dan 5:18** the Most High God gave Nebuchadnezzar your father a kingdom
- Dan 7:18,22,25,27 the saints of the Most High shall receive the kingdom...a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High...He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, Shall persecute the saints of the Most High...Then the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High
- Mark 5:7 What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God
- **Luke 1:31-32,35,76** you...shall call His name Jesus. He will be great, and will be called **the Son of the Highest**...The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and **the power of the Highest** will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God...And you, child, will be called **the prophet of the Highest**; For you will go before the face of the Lord to prepare His ways
- Heb 7:1 Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God

The LORD; The LORD God; The Lord GOD; The Lord God

- **Gen 15:1-2,5-7** After these things **the word of the LORD** came to Abram in a vision, saying, Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceeding great reward. But Abram said, **Lord GOD**, what will You give me, seeing I go childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus...Then He brought him outside and said, Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them. And He said to him, So shall your descendants be. And he believed in **the LORD**, and He accounted it to him for righteousness. Then He said to him, **I am the LORD**, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it
- **Ex 23:17-19** Three times in the year all your males shall appear before **the Lord GOD**. You shall not offer the blood of My sacrifice with leavened bread; nor shall the fat of My sacrifice remain until morning. The first of the firstfruits of the land you shall bring into **the house of the LORD your God**
- Ex 24:3-4,7-8 Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD and all the judgments. And all the people answered with one voice and said, All the words which the LORD has said we will do. And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD...Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it in the hearing of the people. And they said, All that the LORD has said we will do, and be obedient. And Moses took the blood, sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold, the blood of the covenant which the LORD has made with you according to all these words
- **Ex 25:1,8** Then **the LORD** spoke to Moses, saying...let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them
- **Lev 26:1-2,11-13** I am the LORD your God. You shall keep My Sabbaths and reverence My sanctuary: I am the LORD...I will set My tabernacle among you, and My soul shall not abhor you. I will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people. I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their slaves

- Num 14:13-16,19-21 And Moses said to the LORD: Then the Egyptians will hear it, for by Your might You brought these people up from among them, and they will tell it to the inhabitants of this land. They have heard that You, LORD, are among these people; that You, LORD, are seen face to face and that Your cloud stands above them; and You go before them in a pillar of cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. Now if You kill these people as one man, then the nations which have heard of Your fame will speak, saying, Because the LORD was not able to bring this people to the land which He swore to give them, therefore He killed them in the wilderness...Pardon the iniquity of this people, I pray, according to the greatness of Your mercy, just as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. Then the LORD said: I have pardoned, according to your word; but truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD
- **Deut 7:6-9** you are a holy people to **the LORD your God; the LORD your God** has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples on the face of the earth. **The LORD** did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any other people, for you were the least of all peoples; but because **the LORD** loves you, and because He would keep the oath which He swore to your fathers, **the LORD** has brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you from the house of bondage, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt...know that **the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God** who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments

 in the land of Egypt. You shall fear **the LORD your God**; you shall serve Him, and to Him you
 shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name. He is your praise and **He is your God**
- **Deut 12:5,7** you shall seek the place where **the LORD your God** chooses, out of all your tribes, to put His name for His habitation; and there you shall go...And there you shall eat before **the LORD your God**, and you shall rejoice in all to which you have put your hand, you and your households, in which **the LORD your God** has blessed you
- **Deut 14:1-2** You are the children of the LORD your God, you shall not cut yourselves nor shave the front of your head for the dead. For you are **a holy people to the LORD your God**, and **the LORD has chosen you to be a people for Himself**, a special treasure above all the peoples who are on the face of the earth

- Jos 22:22-24 The LORD God of gods, The LORD God of gods. He knows, and let Israel itself know—if it is in rebellion, or if in treachery against the LORD, do not save us this day...If we have built ourselves an altar to turn from following the LORD...let the LORD Himself require an account...the LORD God of Israel
- **2 Sam 7:22-24** You are great, **O Lord GOD**. For there is none like You, nor is there any God besides You, according to all that we have heard with our ears. - **Ps 22:1,7-8,10,19** *My God, My God*, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping me...All those who see Me laugh Me to scorn; They shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, He trusted in **the LORD**, let Him rescue Him...I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb **You have been My God**...But **You, O LORD**, do not be far from me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me
- **Ps 68:18** You have ascended on high, You have led captivity captive; You have received gifts among men, Even among the rebellious, That **the LORD God** might dwell there (Eph 4:8)
- Ps 83:18 You, whose name alone is the LORD, Are the Most High over all the earth
- **Ps 136:1-3** Oh, give thanks to **the LORD**, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. Oh, give thanks to **the God of gods!** For His mercy endures forever. Oh, give thanks to **the Lord of lords!** For His mercy endures forever
- Isa 25:6-10 And in this mountain The LORD of hosts will make for all people A feast of choice pieces...And He will destroy on this mountain The surface of the covering cast over all people, And the veil that is spread over all nations. He will swallow up death forever, And the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken. And it will be said in that day: Behold, this is our God; We have waited for Him, and He will save us. This is the LORD; We have waited for Him; We will be glad and rejoice in His salvation. For on this mountain the hand of the LORD will rest
- **Isa 28:16** Therefore thus says **the Lord GOD**: Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, A tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; Whoever believes will not act hastily
- Isa 33:22 the LORD is our Judge, The LORD is our Lawgiver, The LORD is our King

- Isa 34:1-4,8-10 Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, The world and all the things that come forth from it. - Jer 10:10 the LORD is the true God; He is the Living God and the everlasting King
- Jer 16:14-15 the days are coming, says the LORD, that it shall no more be said, The LORD lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of Egypt, but, The LORD lives who brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north and from all the lands where He had driven them.

 For I will bring them back into their land which I gave to their fathers
- Jer 31:31-35 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in that day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband [from baal] to them, says the LORD. And I prayed to the LORD my God, and made confession, and said, O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him, and with those who keep His commandments, we have sinned and committed iniquity, we have done wickedly and rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your judgments. Neither have we heeded Your servants the prophets, who spoke in Your name to our kings and our princes, to our fathers and all the people of the land
- Joel 2:29-32 And also upon My menservants and My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: Blood and fire and pillars of smoke. - Amos 4:12-13 Prepare to meet your God, O Israel...The LORD God of hosts is His name

Thus says the LORD of hosts: If it is marvelous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, Will it also be marvelous in My eyes? Says the LORD of hosts. Thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, I will save My people from the land of the east And from the land of the west; I will bring them back, And they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. They shall be My people And I will be their God, In truth and righteousness. Thus says the LORD of hosts: Let your hands be strong, You who have been hearing in these days These words by the mouth of the prophets, Who were in the day That the foundation was laid For the house of the LORD of hosts, That the temple might be built...Thus says **the LORD of hosts**: Peoples shall yet come, Inhabitants of many cities; The inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, Let us continue to go and pray before the LORD, And seek the LORD of hosts. I myself will go also. Yes, many peoples and strong nations Shall come to seek **the LORD of hosts** in Jerusalem, And to pray before the LORD
- **Zech 14:16-17,20-21** And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship **the King, the LORD of hosts**, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. And the Angel of the LORD said to her: Behold, you are with child, And you shall bear a son. You shall call his name Ishmael, Because the LORD has heard your affliction. He shall be a wild man; His hand shall be against every man, And every man's hand against him. And he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren. Then she called the name of the LORD who spoke to her, You-Are-The-God-Who-Sees; for she said, Have I also here seen Him who sees me? Therefore the well was called Beer Lahai Roi [Well of the One Who Lives and Sees Me]
- Gen 22:10-12,15-18 Abraham stretched out his hand and took the knife to slay his son. But the Angel of the LORD called to him from heaven and said, Abraham, Abraham! And he said, here I am. And He said, Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you fear God, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son, from Me...Then the Angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time out of heaven, and said: By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son, in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven...In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed because you have obeyed
- Ex 23:20-23 Behold, I send an Angel before you to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; for My name is in Him. But it you indeed obey His voice and do all that I speak, then I will be an enemy to your enemies and an adversary to your adversaries. For My Angel will go before you and bring you in
- **Ex 32:33-35** And the LORD said to Moses, Whoever has sinned against Me, I will blot him out of My book. Now therefore, go, lead the people to the place of which I have spoken to you. Behold, **My angel shall go before you**. Nevertheless, in the day when I visit for punishment, I will visit punishment upon them for their sin. So the LORD plagued the people because of what they did with the calf which Aaron made.
- **Ex 33:1-3,14-15** Then the LORD said to Moses, Depart and go up from here, you and the people whom you have brought out of the land of Egypt, to the land of which I swore to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, saying, To your descendants I will give it. And I will send My Angel before you, and I will drive out the Canaanite and the Amorite and the Hittite and the Perizzite and the Hivite and the Jebusite. Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; for I will not go up in your midst, lest I consume you on the way for you are a stiff-necked people...And He said, My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest. Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here
- Num 22:20-35 God came to Balaam at night and said to him, If the men come to call you, rise and go with them; but only the word which I speak to you—that you shall do. So Balaam rose in the morning, saddled his donkey, and went with the princes of Moab. Then God's anger was aroused because he went, and the Angel of the LORD took His stand in the way as an adversary against him. And he was riding on his donkey, and his two servants were with him. Now the donkey saw the Angel of the LORD standing in the way with His drawn sword in His hand, and the donkey turned aside out of the way and went into the field. So Balaam struck the donkey to turn her back onto the road. Then the Angel of the LORD stood in a narrow path between the vineyards, with a wall on this side and a wall on that side. And when the donkey saw the Angel of the LORD, she pushed herself against the wall and crushed Balaam's foot against the wall; so he struck her again. Then the Angel of the LORD went further, and stood in a narrow place where there was no way to turn either to the right hand or to the left. And when the donkey saw

the Angel of the LORD, she lay down under Balaam; so Balaam's anger was aroused, and he struck the donkey with his staff. Then the LORD opened the mouth of the donkey, and she said to Balaam, What have I done to you, that you have struck me these three times? And Balaam said to the donkey, Because you have abused me. I wish there were a sword in my hand, for now I would kill you! So the donkey said to Balaam, Am I not your donkey on which you have ridden, ever since I became yours, to this day? Was I ever disposed to do this to you? And he said, No. Then the LORD opened Balaam's eyes, and he saw the Angel of the LORD standing in the way with His drawn sword in His hand; and he bowed his head and fell flat on his face. And the Angel of the LORD said to him, Why have you struck your donkey these three times? Behold, I have come out to stand against you, because your way is perverse before Me. The donkey saw Me and turned aside from Me these three times. If she had not turned aside from Me, surely I would also have killed you by now, and let her live. And Balaam said to the Angel of the LORD, I have sinned, for I did not know You stood in the way against me. Now therefore, if it displeases You, I will turn back. Then the Angel of the LORD said to Balaam, Go with the men, but only the word that I speak to you, that you shall speak

- Judg 2:1-5 Then the Angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said: I led you up from Egypt and brought you to the land of which I swore to your fathers; and I said, I will never break My covenant with you. And you shall make no covenant with the inhabitants of this land; you shall tear down their altars. But you have not obeyed My voice. Why have you done this? Therefore I also said, I will not drive them out before you; but they shall be thorns in your side, and their gods shall be a snare to you. And so it was, when the Angel of the LORD spoke these words to all the children of Israel, that the people lifted up their voice and wept. Then they called the name of that place Bochim; and they sacrificed there to the LORD
- Judg 6:11-24 Now the Angel of the LORD came and sat under the terebinth tree which was in Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, while his son Gideon threshed wheat in the winepress. And the Angel of the LORD appeared to him, and said to him, The LORD is with you, you mighty man of valor! And Gideon said to Him, O my lord, if the LORD is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all His miracles which our fathers told us about, saying, Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt? But now the LORD has forsaken us and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites. Then the LORD turned to him and said, Go in this might of yours, and you shall save Israel from the hand of the Midianites. Have I not sent you? So he said to Him, O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house. And the LORD said to him, Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man. Then he said to Him, If now I have found favor in Your sight, then show me a sign that it is You who talk with me. Do not depart from here, I pray, until I come to You and bring out my offering and set it before You. And He said, I will wait until you come back. Then Gideon went in and prepared a young goat, and unleavened bread from an ephah of flour. The meat he put in a basket, and he put the broth in a pot; and he brought them out to Him under the terebinth tree and presented them. The Angel of God said to him, Take the meat and the unleavened bread and lay them on this rock, and pour out the broth. And he did so. Then the Angel of the LORD put out the end of His staff that was in His hand, and touched the meat and the unleavened bread; and fire rose out of the rock and consumed the meat and the unleavened bread. And the Angel of the LORD departed out of his sight. Now Gideon perceived that He was the Angel of the LORD. So Gideon said, Alas, O Lord GOD! For I have seen the Angel of the LORD face to face. Then the LORD said to him, Peace be with you; do not fear, you shall not die. So Gideon built an altar...to the LORD, and called it The LORD-Shalom

- Judg 13:2-25 there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren and had no children. And the Angel of the LORD appeared to the woman and said to her, Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son. Now therefore, please be careful not to drink wine or similar drink, and not to eat any unclean thing. For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall beain to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines. So the woman came and told her husband, saying, A Man of God came to me, and His countenance was like the countenance of the Angel of God, very awesome; but I did not ask Him where He was from, and He did not tell Me His name...Then Manoah prayed to the LORD, and said, O my Lord, please let the Man of **God** whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born. And God listened to the voice of Manoah, and the Angel of God came to the woman again as she was sittina in the field; but Manoah her husband was not with her. Then the woman ran in haste and told her husband, and said to him, Look, the Man has just now appeared to me, the One who came to me the other day! So Manoah arose and followed his wife. When he came to the Man, he said to Him, Are You the Man who spoke to this woman? And He said, I am. And Manoah said, Now let Your words come to pass! What will be the boy's rule of life, and his work? So the Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, Of all that I said to the woman let her be careful...Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, Please let us detain You, and we will prepare a young goat for You. And the Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, Though you detain Me, I will not eat your food. But if you offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to the LORD. (For Manoah did not know He was the Angel of the LORD.) Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, What is Your name, that when Your words come to pass we may honor You? And the Angel of the LORD said to him, Why do you ask My name, seeing it is wonderful? So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to the LORD. And He did a wondrous thing while Manoah and his wife looked on: as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar, it happened that the Angel of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar. When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell on their faces to the ground. When the Angel of the LORD appeared no more to Manoah and his wife, then Manoah knew that He was the Angel of the LORD. And Manoah said to his wife, We shall surely die, because we have seen God! Then his wife said to him, If the LORD had desired to kill us, He would not have accepted a burnt offering and a grain offering from our hands, nor would He have shown us all these things, nor would He have told us such things as these at this time. So the woman bore a son and called his name Samson; and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him. And the Spirit of the LORD began to move upon him at Mahaneh Dan
- **Isa 63:8-10** For He said, Surely these are My people, Children who will not lie. So He became their Savior. In all their affliction He was afflicted, And **the Angel of His Presence saved them**; In His love and in His pity He redeemed them; And He bore them and carried them All the days of old. But they rebelled and grieved His Holy Spirit
- Dan 3:25,28 Look! he answered, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire; and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God...Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego, who sent His Angel and delivered His servants who trusted in Him
- **Hos 12:2-5** The LORD also brings a charge against Judah...He took his brother by the heel in the womb, And in his strength **he struggled with God**. Yes, **he struggled with the Angel** and prevailed; He wept, and sought favor from Him. He found Him in Bethel, And there He spoke to us—That is, the LORD of hosts, The LORD is His memorial

- **Zech 1:12** Then **the Angel of the LORD** answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long will You not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which You were angry these seventy years
- Zech 3:1-7 Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the Angel of the LORD...Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and was standing before the Angel. Then He answered and spoke to those who stood before Him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And to him he said, See, I have removed your iniquity from you, and I will clothe you with rich robes...Then the Angel of the LORD admonished Joshua, saying, Thus says the LORD of hosts: If you will walk in My ways, And if you will keep My command, Then you shall also judge My house, And likewise have charge of My courts
- **Zech 12:8** In that day the LORD will defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; the one who is feeble among them in that day shall be like David, and the house of David shall be **like God, like the Angel of the LORD** before them
- Acts 7:29-38 Moses fled and became a sojourner in the land of Midian, where he had two sons. And when forty years had passed an Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire in a bush, in the wilderness of Mount Sinai. When Moses saw it, he marveled at the sight and as he drew near to observe, the voice of the Lord came to him, saying, I am the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses trembled and dared not look. Then the LORD said to him, Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy ground. I have certainly seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt; I have heard their groaning and have come down to deliver them. And now come, I will send you to Egypt. This Moses whom they rejected, saying, Who made you a ruler and a judge? is the one God sent to be a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the Angel who appeared to him in the bush. He brought them out, after he had shown wonders and signs in the land of Egypt, and in the Red Sea, and in the wilderness forty years. This is that Moses who said to the children of Israel, The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear. This is he who was in the congregation in the wilderness with the Angel who spoke to him on Mount Sinai
