#### John

**1: 1.** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2. He was in the beginning with God. 3. All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. 6. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.

**1:12.** But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of **God**, even to those who believe in His name: 13. who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of **God**.

**1:18.** No one has seen **God** at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him.

**1:29.** The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! **The Lamb of God** who takes away the sin of the world!

**1:34.** "And I have seen and testified that this is **the Son of God**." 35. Again, the next day, John stood with two of his disciples. 36. And looking at Jesus as He walked, he said, "Behold **the Lamb of God**!"

**1:49.** Nathanael answered and said to Him, "Rabbi, You are **the Son of God**! You are the King of Israel!" 50. Jesus answered and said to him, "Because I said to you, `I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe? You will see greater things than these." 51. And He said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, hereafter you shall see heaven open, and the angels of **God** ascending and descending upon the Son of Man."

**3:2.** This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from **God**; for no one can do these signs that You do unless **God** is with him." 3. Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of **God**." 4. Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" 5. Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of **God**.

**3:16.** "For **God** so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17. "For **God** did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. 18. "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of **the only begotten Son of God**. 19. "And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. 20. "For everyone

practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. 21. "But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in **God**."

**3:33.** "He who has received His testimony has certified that **God** is true. 34. "For He whom **God** has sent speaks the words of **God**, for **God** does not give the Spirit by measure. 35. "The Father loves the Son, and has given all things into His hand.

**4:10.** Jesus answered and said to her, "If you knew the gift of **God**, and who it is who says to you, `Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water."

**4:23.** "But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24. "**God** is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

**5:18.** Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that **God** was His Father, making Himself equal with **God**.

**5:25.** "Most assuredly, I say to you, the hour is coming, and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of *the Son of God*; and those who hear will live.

**5:41.** "I do not receive honor from men. 42. "But I know you, that you do not have the love of **God** in you. 43. "I have come in My Father's name, and you do not receive Me; if another comes in his own name, him you will receive. 44. "How can you believe, who receive honor from one another, and do not seek the honor that comes from the only **God**?

**6:27.** "Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because **God the Father** has set His seal on Him." 28. Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of **God**?" 29. Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of **God**, that you believe in Him whom He sent."

<u>6:32.</u> Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. 33. "For the bread of **God** is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world."

**6:44.** "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day. 45. "It is written in the prophets, `And they shall all be taught by **God**.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me. 46. "Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from **God**; He has seen the Father.

**6:68.** Then Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. 69. "Also we have come to believe and know that You are the Christ, **the Son of the living God**."

**7:16.** Jesus answered them and said, "My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me. 17. "If anyone wants to do His will, he shall know concerning the doctrine, whether it is from **God** or whether I speak on My own authority.

**8:40.** "But now you seek to kill Me, a Man who has told you the truth which I heard from **God**. Abraham did not do this. 41. "You do the deeds of your father." Then they said to Him, "We were not born of fornication; we have one **Father God**." 42. Jesus said to them, "If **God** were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from **God**; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me.

8:47. "He who is of God hears God's words; therefore you do not hear, because you are not of God."

**8:54.** Jesus answered, "If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your **God**.

**9:3.** Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of **God** should be revealed in him.

**9:16.** Therefore some of the Pharisees said, "This Man is not from **God**, because He does not keep the Sabbath." Others said, "How can a man who is a sinner do such miracles?" And there was a division among them.

**9:24.** So they again called the man who was blind, and said to him, "Give **God** the glory! We know that this Man is a sinner." 25. He answered and said, "Whether He is a sinner or not I do not know. One thing I know: that though I was blind, now I see." 26. Then they said to him again, "What did He do to you? How did He open your eyes?" 27. He answered them, "I told you already, and you did not listen. Why do you want to hear it again? Do you also want to become His disciples?" 28. Then they reviled him and said, "You are His disciple, but we are Moses' disciples. 29. "We know that **God** spoke to Moses; as for this fellow, we do not know where He is from." 30. The man answered and said to them, "Why, this is a marvelous thing, that you do not know where He is from, and yet He has opened my eyes! 31. "Now we know that **God** does not hear sinners; but if anyone is a worshiper of **God** and does His will, He hears him. 32. "Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind. 33. "If this Man were not from **God**, He could do nothing." 34. They answered and said to him, "You were completely born in sins, and are you teaching us?" And they cast him out. 35. Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in **the Son of God**?"

**10:33.** The Jews answered Him, saying, "For a good work we do not stone You, but for blasphemy, and because You, being a Man, make Yourself **God**." 34. Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your law, `I said, "You are gods" '? 35. "If He called them gods, to whom the word of **God** came (and the Scripture cannot be broken), 36. "do you say of Him whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, `You are blaspheming,' because I said, `I am **the Son of God**'?

**11:4.** When Jesus heard that, He said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of **God**, that **the Son of God** may be glorified through it."

**11:21.** Then Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died. 22. "But even now I know that whatever You ask of **God**, **God** will give You."

**11:27.** She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, **the Son of God**, who is to come into the world."

**11:39.** Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of him who was dead, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there is a stench, for he has been dead four days." 40. Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of **God**?"

**11:51.** Now this he did not say on his own authority; but being high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus would die for the nation, 52. and not for that nation only, but also that He would gather together in one the children of **God** who were scattered abroad.

**12:42.** Nevertheless even among the rulers many believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they did not confess Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue; 43. for they loved the praise of men more than the praise of **God**.

**13:3.** Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from **God** and was going to **God**, 4. rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.

**13:31.** So, when he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and **God** is glorified in Him. 32. "If **God** is glorified in Him, **God** will also glorify Him in Himself, and glorify Him immediately.

**14:1.** "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in **God**, believe also in Me. 2. "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

**16:2.** "They will put you out of the synagogues; yes, the time is coming that whoever kills you will think that he offers **God** service. 3. "And these things they will do to you because they have not known the Father nor Me.

**16:26.** "In that day you will ask in My name, and I do not say to you that I shall pray the Father for you; 27. "for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from **God**.

**16:30.** "Now we are sure that You know all things, and have no need that anyone should question You. By this we believe that You came forth from **God**."

**17:3.** "And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true **God**, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

**20:17.** Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, `I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My **God** and your **God**.'"

**20:27.** Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand here, and put it into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing." 28. And Thomas answered and said to Him, "**My Lord and my God**!"

**20:30.** And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31. but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, **the Son of God**, and that believing you may have life in His name.

**21:19.** This He spoke, signifying by what death he would glorify **God**.

## 1 John

**1:5.** This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that **God** is light and in Him is no darkness at all. 6. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. 7. But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

**2:5.** But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of **God** is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him. 6. He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

**2:14.** I have written to you, fathers, because you have known Him who is from the beginning. I have written to you, young men, because you are strong, and the word of **God** abides in you, and you have overcome the wicked one. 15. Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16. For all that is in the world the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world. 17. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of **God** abides forever.

**3:1.** Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of **God**! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. 2. Beloved, now we are children of **God**; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

**3:8.** He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose **the Son of God** was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. 9. Whoever has been born of **God** does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of **God**. 10. In this the children of **God** and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of **God**, nor is he who does not love his brother.

**3:17.** But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of **God** abide in him? 18. My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth. 19. And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him. 20. For if our heart condemns us, **God** is greater than our heart, and knows all things. 21. Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward **God**. 22. And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. 23. And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.

**4:1.** Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of **God**; because many false prophets have gone out into the world. 2. By this you know the Spirit of **God**: Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of **God**, 3. and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of **God**. And this is the spirit of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world. 4. You are of **God**, little children, and have overcome them,

because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. 5. They are of the world. Therefore they speak as of the world, and the world hears them. 6. We are of **God**. He who knows **God** hears us; he who is not of **God** does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error. 7. Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of **God**; and everyone who loves is born of **God** and knows **God**. 8. He who does not love does not know God, for God is love. 9. In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that **God** has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. 10. In this is love, not that we loved **God**, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 11. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. 12. No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, **God** abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us. 13. By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. 14. And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son as Savior of the world. 15. Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. 16. And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him. 17. Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world. 18. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. 19. We love Him because He first loved us. 20. If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love **God** whom he has not seen? 21. And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves **God** must love his brother also.

**5:1.** Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of **God**, and everyone who loves Him who begot also loves him who is begotten of Him. 2. By this we know that we love the children of **God**, when we love **God** and keep His commandments. 3. For this is the love of **God**, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome. 4. For whatever is born of **God** overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world our faith. 5. Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is **the Son of God**?

**5:9.** If we receive the witness of men, the witness of **God** is greater; for this is the witness of **God** which He has testified of His Son. 10. He who believes in **the Son of God** has the witness in himself; he who does not believe **God** has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that **God** has given of His Son. 11. And this is the testimony: that **God** has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. 12. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have **the Son of God** does not have life. 13. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of **the Son of God**, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of **the Son of God**.

**5:18.** We know that whoever is born of **God** does not sin; but he who has been born of **God** keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him. 19. We know that we are of **God**, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one. 20. And we know that **the Son of God** has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true **God** and eternal life.

### 2 John

**1:3.** Grace, mercy, and peace will be with you from **God the Father** and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

**1:9.** Whoever transgresses and does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have **God**. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.

## 3 John

**1:5.** Beloved, you do faithfully whatever you do for the brethren and for strangers, 6. who have borne witness of your love before the church. If you send them forward on their journey in a manner worthy of **God**, you will do well, 7. because they went forth for His name's sake, taking nothing from the Gentiles.

**1:11.** Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. He who does good is of **God**, but he who does evil has not seen **God**.

### Revelation

**1:1.** The Revelation of **Jesus Christ**, which **God** gave Him to show His servants things which must shortly take place. And He sent and signified it by His angel to His servant John, 2. who bore witness to the word of **God**, and to the testimony of **Jesus Christ**, and to all things that he saw. 3. Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near. 4. John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from **Him who is and who was and who is to come**, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, 5. and from **Jesus Christ**, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6. and has made us kings and priests to **His God and Father**, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. 7. Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, and they also who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen. 8. "**I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." 9. I, John, both your brother and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of <b>Jesus Christ**, was on the island that is called Patmos for the word of **God** and for the testimony of **Jesus Christ**.

**2:7.** "He who has an ear, let him hear what **the Spirit** says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of **God**." '

**2:18.** "And to the angel of the church in Thyatira write, `These things says **the Son of God**, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass:

**3:1.** "And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, `These things says **He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars**: "I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead. 2. "Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before **God**. 3. "Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.

**3:12.** "He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of **My God**, and he shall go out no more. And I will write on him the name of **My God** and the name of the city of **My God**, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from **My God**. And I will write on him My new name.

**4:2.** Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and **One sat on the throne**. 3. And **He who sat there** was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald. 4. Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads. 5. And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. And there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of **God**. 6. Before the throne there

was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. 7. The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. 8. And the four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" 9. Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10. the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: 11. "You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created."

**5:6.** And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood **a Lamb** as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. 7. Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of **Him who sat on the throne**. 8. Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before **the Lamb**, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. 9. And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for You were slain, and have redeemed us to **God** by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, 10. and have made us kings and priests to our **God**; and we shall reign on the earth." 11. Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, 12. saying with a loud voice: "Worthy is **the Lamb** who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!" 13. And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: "Blessing and honor and glory and power be to **Him who sits on the throne**, and to **the Lamb**, forever and ever!"

**6:9.** When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of **God** and for the testimony which they held.

**6:15.** And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, 16. and said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of **Him who sits on the throne** and from the wrath of **the Lamb**! 17. "For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"

**7:2.** Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of **the living God**. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea, 3. saying, "Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our **God** on their foreheads."

**7:9.** After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before **the Lamb**, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, 10. and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Salvation belongs to our **God who sits on the throne**, and to **the Lamb**!" 11. And all the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and might, be to our **God** forever and ever. Amen." 13. Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?" 14. And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he

said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of **the Lamb**. 15. "Therefore they are before the throne of **God**, and serve Him day and night in His temple. And **He who sits on the throne** will dwell among them. 16. "They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any heat; 17. "for **the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne** will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And **God** will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

**8:1.** When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. 2. And I saw the seven angels who stand before **God**, and to them were given seven trumpets. 3. Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. And he was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. 4. And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before **God** from the angel's hand.

**9:4.** They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of **God** on their foreheads.

**9:13.** Then the sixth angel sounded: And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before **God** 

**10:5.** And the angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land lifted up his hand to heaven 6. and swore by **Him who lives forever and ever**, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer, 7. but in the days of the sounding of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, the mystery of **God** would be finished, as He declared to His servants the prophets.

**11:1.** Then I was given a reed like a measuring rod. And the angel stood, saying, "Rise and measure the temple of **God**, the altar, and those who worship there. 2. "But leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles. And they will tread the holy city under foot for forty-two months. 3. "And I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth." 4. These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before **the God of the earth**.

**11:11.** Now after the three and a half days the breath of life from **God** entered them, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them. 12. And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." And they ascended to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies saw them. 13. In the same hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. In the earthquake seven thousand men were killed, and the rest were afraid and gave glory to the **God** of heaven.

**11:15.** Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our **Lord** and of **His Christ**, and He shall reign forever and ever!" 16. And the twenty-four elders who sat before **God** on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped **God**, 17. saying: "We give You thanks, O **Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was and who is to come**, because You have taken Your great power and reigned. 18. The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, and those who fear Your name, small and great, and should destroy those who destroy the earth." 19. Then the temple of **God** was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.

**12:5.** And she bore a male **Child** who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her **Child** was caught up to **God** and to His throne. 6. Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by **God**, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days.

**12:10.** Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our **God**, and the power of **His Christ** have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our **God** day and night, has been cast down.

**12:17.** And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of **God** and have the testimony of **Jesus Christ**.

**13:6.** Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against **God**, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven.

**14:1.** Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and fortyfour thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads. 2. And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps. 3. And they sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth. 4. These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow **the Lamb** wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to **God** and to **the Lamb**. 5. And in their mouth was found no guile, for they are without fault before the throne of **God**. 6. Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people 7. saying with a loud voice, "Fear **God** and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water." 8. And another angel followed, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication." 9. Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10. "he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of **God**, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. And he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. 11. "And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." 12. Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of **God** and the faith of Jesus.

**14:19.** So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of **God**.

**15:1.** Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of **God** is complete. 2. And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of **God**. 3. And they sing the song of Moses, the servant of **God**, and the song of **the Lamb**, saying: "Great and marvelous are Your works, **Lord God Almighty**! Just and true are Your ways, O **King of the saints**! 4. Who shall not fear You, O **Lord**, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, for Your judgments have been manifested." 5. After these things I looked, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened. 6. And out of the temple came the seven angels

having the seven plagues, clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands.
7. Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever.
8. The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.

**16:1.** Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of **God** on the earth."

**16:4.** Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood. 5. And I heard the angel of the waters saying: "You are righteous, O Lord, the One who is and who was and who is to be, because You have judged these things. 6. For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due." 7. And I heard another from the altar saying, "Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments." 8. Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire. 9. And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of **God** who has power over these plaques; and they did not repent and give Him glory. 10. Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. 11. And they blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds. 12. Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared. 13. And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. 14. For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of **God** Almighty.

**16:19.** Now the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And great Babylon was remembered before **God**, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath. 20. Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. 21. And great hail from heaven fell upon men, every hailstone about the weight of a talent. And men blasphemed **God** because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.

**17:14.** "These will make war with **the Lamb**, and **the Lamb** will overcome them, for He is **Lord of lords and King of kings**; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful." 15. And he said to me, "The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues. 16. "And the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire. 17. "For **God** has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of **God** are fulfilled.

**18:4.** And I heard another voice from heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues. 5. "For her sins have reached to heaven, and **God** has remembered her iniquities. 6. "Render to her just as she rendered to you, and repay her double according to her works; in the cup which she has mixed, mix for her double. 7. "In the measure that she glorified herself and lived luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow; for she says in her heart, 'I sit as queen, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow.' 8. "Therefore her plagues will come in one day death and mourning and famine. And she will be utterly burned with fire, for strong is **the Lord God** who judges her.

**18:20.** "Rejoice over her, O heaven, and you holy apostles and prophets, for **God** has avenged you on her!"

**19:1.** After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and alory and honor and power to the Lord our God! 2. "For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her." 3. Again they said, "Alleluia! And her smoke rises up forever and ever!" 4. And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, "Amen! Alleluia!" 5. Then a voice came from the throne, saying, "Praise our **God**, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!" 6. And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! 7. "Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of **the Lamb** has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8. And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. 9. Then he said to me, "Write: `Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!" "And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God." 10. And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of **Jesus**. Worship **God**! For the testimony of **Jesus** is the spirit of prophecy." 11. Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called **The Word of God**. 14. And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15. Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. 17. Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of **the great God**, 18. "that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great."

**20:4.** And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to **Jesus** and for the word of **God**, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with **Christ** for a thousand years. 5. But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. 6. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of **God** and of **Christ**, and shall reign with Him a thousand years. 7. Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison 8. and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. 9. They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from **God** out of heaven and devoured them. 10. And the devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. 11. Then I saw **a great white throne and Him who sat on it**, from whose face the earth and great, standing before **God**, and books were opened. And

another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.

**21:1.** And I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. 2. Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from **God**, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. 3. And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of **God** is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. 4. "And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying; and there shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away." 5. Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful." 6. And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. 7. "He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. 8. "But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death." 9. Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." 10. And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from **God**, 11. having the glory of **God**. And her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal.

**21:22.** But I saw no temple in it, for **the Lord God Almighty** and **the Lamb** are its temple. 23. And the city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of **God** illuminated it, and **the Lamb** is its light.

**22:1.** And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of **God** and of **the Lamb.** 2. In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. 3. And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of **God** and of **the Lamb** shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. 4. They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. 5. And there shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for **the Lord God** gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever. 6. Then he said to me, "These words are faithful and true." And **the Lord God** of the holy prophets sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place. 7. "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book." 8. Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. 9. Then he said to me, "See that you do not do that. For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book." Worship **God**."

**22:12.** "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. 13. "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last." 14. Blessed are those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. 15. But outside are dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie. 16. "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star." 17. And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. And whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely. 18. For I testify to

everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, **God** will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; 19. and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, **God** shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book. 20. He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen. Even so, come, **Lord Jesus**! 21. The grace of our **Lord Jesus Christ** be with you all. Amen.
