Deut 6:16 You shall not tempt the LORD your God as you tempted Him in Massa

Matt 4:10 Then Jesus said to him, Away with you Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only shall you serve (Luke 4:8)

Deut 6:13 You shall fear the LORD your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name. You shall not go after other gods

Matt 26:31 I will strike the Shepherd, And the sheep of the flock will be scattered (Mark 14:27)

Zech 13:7-9 Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, Against the Man who is My Companion, Says the LORD of hosts. Strike the Shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones. And it shall come to pass in all the land, Says the LORD, That two thirds in it shall be cut off and die, But one third shall be left in it: I will bring the one third through the fire, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, This is My people; And each one will say, The LORD is my God

Mark 12:24-27 Jesus answered and said to them, Are you not therefore mistaken, because you do not know the scriptures nor the power of God? For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven. But concerning the dead, that they rise, have you not read in the book of Moses, in the burning bush passage, how God spoke to him, saying, I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? He is not the God of the living (Luke 20:37-38; Acts 7:30-32)

Ex 3:4,6,15 So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said...**I am the God of your father—The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**...Moreover God said to Moses, Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: **The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations

Ex 6:2-3 God spoke to Moses and said to him: I am the LORD. I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty but by My name, LORD, I was not known to them

(Acts 3:13) The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His servant Jesus

(Acts 5:30-31) **The God of our fathers raised up Jesus** whom you murdered by hanging on a tree. Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins

Luke 2:21-23 His name was called Jesus...Now when the days of her purification according to the law of Moses were completed, they brought Him to Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord (as it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male who opens the womb shall be called holy to the LORD), and to offer a sacrifice according to what is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons

Ex 13:1-3,12,15 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, **Sanctify to Me all the firstborn**, **whatever opens the womb among the children of Israel, both of man and animal; it is Mine**. And Moses said...you shall set apart to the LORD all that open the womb...Therefore I sacrifice to the LORD all males that open the womb

Lev 12:1,8 Then the LORD spoke to Moses...if she is not able to bring a lamb, then **she may** bring two turtledoves or two young pigeons

Luke 4:10-11 For it is written: He shall give His angels charge over You, To keep You, and, In their hands they shall bear You up, Lest You dash Your foot against a stone

Ps 91:9-12 Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your habitation, No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; For **He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. They shall bear you up in their hands, Lest you dash your foot against a stone**

Luke 4:18-19 The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To preach deliverance to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed, To preach the acceptable year of the LORD

Isa 61:1-2 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, And the day of vengeance of our God

Luke 22:37 And He was numbered with the transgressors

Isa 53:10,12 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand...Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured His soul out unto death, **And He was numbered with the transgressors**, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors

Luke 23:46 Jesus cried out with a loud voice, He said, Father, into Your hands I commend My spirit

Ps 31:1,5 *In You, O LORD, I put my trust...Into Your hand I commit my spirit*; You have redeemed me, O LORD God of truth

John 2:16-17 He said to those who sold doves, Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise! Then His disciples remembered that it was written, Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up

Ps 69:6-9 Let not those who wait for You, O Lord GOD of hosts, be ashamed because of me; Let not those who seek You be confounded because of me, O God of Israel. Because for Your sake I have borne reproach; Shame has covered my face. I have become a stranger to my brothers, And an alien to my mother's children; Because **zeal for Your house has eaten me up**

John 6:31-33 Our fathers ate the manna in the dessert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat. Then Jesus said to them, Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world

Ex 16:4 the LORD said to Moses, Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you

Neh 9:6,7,9,13,14-15 You alone are the LORD...You are the LORD God, Who chose Abram...You saw the affliction of our fathers in Egypt...You came down also on Mount Sinai, And spoke with them from heaven...You made known to them Your holy Sabbath, And commanded them precepts, statutes and laws, By the hand of Moses Your servant. **You gave them bread from heaven for their hunger**, And brought them water out of the rock for their thirst, And told them to go in to possess the land Which You had sworn to give them

Ps 78:21-24 the LORD heard this and was furious; So a fire was kindled against Jacob, And anger also came up against Israel, Because they did not believe in God, And did not trust in His salvation. Yet **He had commanded the clouds above, And opened the doors of heaven, Had** *rained down manna on them to eat, And given them the bread of heaven*. Men ate angels' food; He sent them food to the full

John 6:45 It is written in the prophets, And **they shall all be taught by God**. Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me

Isa 54:13 *All your children shall be taught by the LORD*, and great shall be the peace of your children

John 12:37-38 But although He had done so many signs before them, they did not believe in Him, that the word of Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke: Lord, who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed

Isa 53:1-6 **Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?** For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all

Acts 2:25-27 I have set the LORD always before me, Because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved. Therefore my heart rejoiced, and my tongue was glad; Moreover my flesh will also rest in hope, Because You will not leave my soul in Hades, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption (Acts 13:35)

Ps 16:8-10 I foresaw the LORD always before my face, For He is at my right hand, that I may not be shaken; Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope. For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption

Acts 3:22-23 The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from among your brethren. Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you. And it shall come to pass that every soul who will not hear that Prophet shall be utterly destroyed from among the people (Acts 7:37)

Deut 18:15,18-19 The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, from your brethren. Him you shall hear...I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. And it shall be that whoever will not hear My words, which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him

Acts 3:25-26 You are sons of the prophets, and of the covenant God made with our fathers, saying to Abraham, And **in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed**

Gen 22:18 In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed

Gen 26:4-5 And I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and **in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed**

Gen 28:13-14 behold, the LORD stood above it and said: I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants. Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and **in your seed all the families of the earth** shall be blessed

Acts 4:26 The kings of the earth took their stand, And the rulers were gathered together Against the LORD and against His Christ

Ps 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, **Against the LORD and against His Anointed**

Acts 13:22-23 when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom He also gave testimony and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after my own heart, who will do all my will. From this man's seed, according to the promise, God raised up for Israel a Savior—Jesus

1 Sam 13:14 **The LORD has sought for Himself a man after His own heart**, and the LORD has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the LORD commanded you

Rom 2:5-6,16 in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, who will render to each one according to his deeds...in the day when God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ

Ps 62:11-12 God has spoken once, Twice I have heard this: That power belongs to God. Also to You, O LORD, belongs mercy; For **You render to each one according to his work**

Rom 2:24 The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you (vs 16 – God/Jesus Christ)

Isa 52:4-6 thus says the Lord GOD: My people went down at first Into Egypt to dwell there; Then the Assyrian oppressed them without cause. Now therefore, what have I here, says the LORD, **That My people are taken away for nothing? Those who rule over them Make them wail, says the LORD, And My name is blasphemed continually every day**. Therefore My people shall know My name; Therefore they shall know in that day That I am He who speaks: Behold, it is I

Ezek 36:22-23 say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: I do not do this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name's sake, which you have profaned among the nations wherever you went. And I will sanctify My great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst; and the nations shall know that I am the LORD, says the Lord GOD, when I am hallowed in you before their eyes

Romans 4:3,20-24 Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness...He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform. And therefore it was accounted to him for righteousness. Now it was not written for his sake alone that it was imputed to him, but also for us. It shall be imputed to us who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead

Gen 15:1-6 After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceeding great reward. But Abram said, Lord GOD, what will You give me, seeing I go childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus? Then Abram said, Look, You have given me no offspring; indeed one born in my house is my heir! And behold, the word of the LORD came to him, saying, This one shall not be your heir, but one who will come from your own body shall be your heir. Then He brought him outside and said, Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them. And He said to him, So shall your descendants be. And **he believed in the LORD, and He accounted it to him for righteousness**

Rom 12:19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, Vengeance is Mine, I will repay, says the Lord

Deut 32:35-36 *Vengeance is Mine, and recompense*; Their foot shall slip in due time; For the day of their calamity is at hand, And the things to come hasten upon them. For the LORD will judge His people

Rom 15:3 For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written, The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me

Ps 69:5-6,9 *O God...O Lord GOD of hosts...O God of Israel...***the reproaches of those who** *reproach You have fallen on Me*

Rom 15:8-9 Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made to the fathers, and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy, as it is written: For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to your name

2 Sam 22:50 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name

Ps 18:49 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name

Rom 15:11 Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples (vs 8-9 – Jesus Christ/God)

Ps 117:1-2 **Praise the LORD, all you Gentiles! Laud Him, all you peoples!** For His merciful kindness is great toward us, And the truth of the LORD endures forever. Praise the LORD

1 Cor 1:27,29-31 God has chosen the foolish things of the world to put to shame the wise...that no flesh should glory in His presence. But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption—that, as it is written, He who glories, let him glory in the LORD

Jer 9:24 *let him who glories glory in this, That he understands and knows Me, That I am the LORD, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight, says the LORD*

1 Cor 2:14-16 the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one. For who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ

Isa 40:13 Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, Or as His counselor has taught Him

1 Cor 3:19-21,23 the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He catches the wise in their own craftiness; and again, The LORD knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile. Therefore let no one boast in men...And you are Christ's, and Christ is God's

Ps 94:11 The LORD knows the thoughts of man, That they are futile

1 Cor 15:27-28 For **He has put all things under His feet**. But when He says all things are put under Him, it is evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted. Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be made subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all

Ps 8:6,9 You have put all things under his feet...O LORD, our Lord, How excellent is Your name in all the Earth

2 Cor 6:15-16 what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people

Lev 26:12-13 *I will walk among you and be your God, and you shall be My people. I am the LORD your God*, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their slaves

Gal 3:6-8 Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Therefore know that only those who are of the faith are sons of Abraham. And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the nations by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, **In you all the nations shall be blessed**

Gen 12:1,3 Now the LORD had said to Abraham...I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And **in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed**

Gen 18:17-18 And the LORD said, Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and **all the nations of the earth shall be blessed** in him

Gal 3:16-18 Now to Abraham and to his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, And to seeds, as of many, but as of one, And to your Seed, who is Christ. And this I say, that the law, which was four hundred and thirty years later, cannot annul the covenant that was confirmed before by God in Christ, that it should make the promise of no effect. For if the inheritance is of the law, it is no longer a promise; but God gave it to Abraham by promise

Gen 22:15-18 The Angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time out of heaven, and said, By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son, in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies. **In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed**, because you have obeyed My voice

Gen 26:2,4-5 Then the LORD appeared to him and said...I will make your descendants multiply as the stars of heaven; I will give to your descendants all these lands; and **in your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed**; because Abraham obeyed My voice

Gen 28:13-14 behold, the LORD stood above it and said: I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants. Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and **in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed**

Heb 2:3-10 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will? For He has not put the world to come, of which we speak, in subjection to angels. But one testified in a certain place, saying: What is man that You are mindful of him, Or the son of man that You take care of him? You made him a little lower than the angels; You crowned him with glory and honor, And set him over the works of Your hands. You have put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that He put all in subjection under him. He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him. But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the author of their salvation perfect through sufferings

Ps 8:1,4-6 O LORD, our Lord...What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him? For You have made him a little lower than the angels, And You have crowned him with glory and honor. You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands

 Heb 2:11-13 He is not ashamed to call them brethren, saying: I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the congregation I will sing praise to You. And again: I will put My trust in Him. And again: Here am I and the children whom God has given Me

Isa 8:16-18 Bind up the testimony, Seal the law among my disciples. And I will wait on the LORD, Who hides His face from the house of Jacob; and I will hope in Him. Here am I and the children whom the LORD has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel From the LORD of hosts, Who dwells in Mount Zion

Heb 5:5 So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: You are My Son, Today I have begotten You (Acts 13:33; Heb 1:5)

Ps 2:7 The LORD has said to Me, You are My Son, Today I have begotten You

Heb 5:6; 7:17,21 You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek

Ps 110:4 The LORD has sworn And will not relent, **You are a priest forever According to the** order of Melchizedek

Heb 6:13-14 For when God made a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you

Gen 22:15-17 the Angel of the LORD called to Abraham a second time out of heaven, and said, By Myself I have sworn, says the LORD, because you have done this thing, and have not withheld your son, your only son, **in blessing I will bless you, and in multiplying I will multiply your descendants** as the stars of heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies

Heb 7:1 Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God

Gen 14:18-22 Then **Melchizedek king of Salem** brought out bread and wine; **he was the priest of God Most High**. And he blessed him and said: Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he gave him a tithe of all. Now the king of Sodom said to Abram, Give me the persons, and take the goods for yourself. But Abram said to the king of Sodom, I have lifted my hand to **the LORD, God Most High**, the Possessor of heaven and earth

Heb 8:1-2,5 We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man...as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle. For He said, See that you make all things according to the pattern shown you on the mountain

Ex 25:1-2,8-9,40 the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: Speak to the children of Israel, that they may bring Me an offering...And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them. According to all that I show you, that is, the pattern of the tabernacle and the pattern of all its furnishings, just so you shall make it...And see to it that you make them according to the pattern which was shown you on the mountain

Heb 8:6-12 He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then no place would have been sought for a second. Because finding fault with them, He says: Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they did not continue in My covenant, and I disregarded them, says the LORD. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel: After those days, says the LORD, I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. None of them shall teach his neighbor, and none his brother, saying, Know the LORD, for all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them. *For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more* (Heb 9:15-20; 10:16-17)

Jer 31:31-34 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My laws in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD, for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more

Heb 10:5-7 when He came into the world, He said: Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body you have prepared for Me. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. Then I said, Behold, I have come—In the volume of the book it is written of me—To do Your will, O God

Ps 40:5-8 Many, O LORD, are Your wonderful works Which You have done; And Your thoughts toward us Cannot be counted to You in order; If I would declare and speak of them, They are more than can be numbered. Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. Then I said, Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me. I delight to do Your will, O my God

Heb 10:29-31 Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? For we know Him who said, Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, says the Lord. And again, The LORD will judge His people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the Living God

Deut 32:35-36 Vengeance is Mine, and recompense; Their foot shall slip in due time; For the day of their calamity is at hand, And the things to come hasten upon them. For **the LORD will judge His people** And have compassion upon His servants

James 2:23 Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. And he was called the friend of God

2 Chronicles 20:6-8 *O LORD God of our fathers, are You not God in heaven, and do You not rule over the all kingdoms of the nations, and in Your hand is there not power and might, so that no one is able to withstand You? Are You not our God, who drove out the inhabitants of this land from before Your people Israel, and gave it to the descendants of Abraham Your friend* forever? And they dwelt in it, and have built You a sanctuary in it for Your name

Isaiah 41:4,8 *I, the LORD, am the first; And with the last I am He...But you, Israel, are My servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, The descendants of* **Abraham My friend**

1 Pet **1:15-16** as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, Be holy, for I am holy (John 6:44,65)

Lev 11:44-45 *I am the LORD your God. You shall therefore consecrate yourselves, and you shall be holy, for I am holy.* Neither shall you defile yourselves with any creeping thing that creeps upon the earth. For I am the LORD who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy

Lev 19:1-2 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, Speak to all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say to them: **You shall be holy, for I the LORD your God am holy**

Lev 20:7 Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am the LORD your God

1 Pet 2:4-6 Coming to Him as a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. Therefore it is also contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion A chief cornerstone, elect, precious, And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame

Isa 28:16 thus says the Lord GOD: Behold, I lay in Zion a stone for a foundation, A tried stone, a precious cornerstone, a sure foundation; Whoever believes will not act hastily

1 Pet 2:21-22 to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow in His steps: **Who committed no sin, Nor was guile found in His mouth**

Isa 53:9-10 they made His grave with the wicked—But with the rich at His death, Because **he had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth**. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief

1 Pet 5:5-7,10 *God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble*. Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, casting your care upon Him, for He cares for you...But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you (James 4:6)

Pro 3:33-34 *The curse of the LORD is on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of the just. Surely* **He scorns the scornful, But gives grace to the humble**
